### A new crop of co-op leaders

AMERICA'S electric co-op story, so far, has been written by members, board members, and co-op employees who experienced rural electrification either firsthand or through their parents. These leaders remember "getting the lights" and have shepherded co-op growth over the past seven decades — a period that encompasses every-

thing from the first lines being built to today's environment of digital metering and paying bills by smartphone. But, as the baby boomers (ages 51-69) enter retirement, the question of who will write the next chapters of co-op history arises more frequently in co-op circles.

The National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) reports that, within the next five years, 20 percent of America's electric cooperative employees will be eligible for retirement. In fact, NRECA says that in the next several years, our country will see a major shift in the professional landscape. Many businesses — Valley Rural Electric included — are already noticing this change as the baby-boomer generation moves into retirement and their children and grand-children, members of the millennial generation (ages 18-34), begin to move into the workforce and advance in their careers.

Co-ops will be looking to future generations to move us forward as the economy and government regulations evolve. The new class of co-op leaders and employees will have to navigate these challenges while ensuring that we remain true to our mission: providing safe, reliable, and affordable electric service, and improving the quality of life for our members.

Adam Schwartz, a columnist and founder of the co-op support organization, The Cooperative Way, wrote recently that co-ops have an obligation to help the next generation prepare to lead their cooperatives. While veteran cooperative leaders have experience and historical perspective, Schwartz says, the young are not burdened by knowing how things have always been done and offer a fresh perspective.

"Their naiveté refreshes us and challenges us to see things in a new light so that our community can continue to be attractive to young people," Schwartz writes.

Fortunately, co-ops are great places for millennials to have a career. The millennial generation is the largest population of adults to move into the workforce since the baby-boomer generation. NRECA describes this new crop of Americans as highly educated and motivated by the ability to gain work experience that can turn into a meaningful and rewarding career, especially since they weathered a recession during or immediately after trying to break into the workforce.

Driven by values and attracted to a company's strong mission and culture over salary and compensation, millennials are uniquely suited for careers at their local electric cooperatives. That's because the dedication of cooperatives (such as Valley Rural Electric) to our communities and our focus on people, not profits, creates an ideal work environment for individuals seeking to develop meaningful careers.
